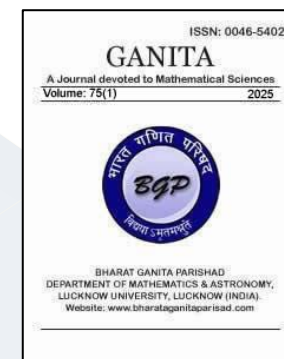

The journal GANITA is a peer reviewed journal listed in the UGC Care List and the papers published in the journal are reviewed in Mathematical Reviews.

Young Scientist Award

In order to encourage young mathematicians, BGP has instituted prize of Rs. 2000 for best paper and its presentation (in area of pure mathematics/applied mathematics). Following points may be noted for the papers to be considered for the prize:

- 1. Maximum age limit is 40 years by November 06, 2025.
- 2. Papers by joint authors will not be considered.
- 3. Only original and unpublished work will be considered. The papers will be reviewed by experts. Papers will have to be presented personally at the conference.
- 4. On the joint basis of review and presentation, selection will be made of the best paper. The decision of the experts will be final.
